Temporary Commercial Use Permit Instructions:

"Temporary commercial use" means temporary use of property for selling products, services, or other activities for profit by a person(s) other than the property owner.

Please note that you will need to follow these instructions to be compliant with the city zoning ordinance.

- 1. You must receive permission from the property owner/business owner to park your trailer.
- 2. You must be on private property, not located on a street or state highway.
- 3. You must fill out the application for temporary commercial use permit and return it to City Hall along with the appropriate fee.
- 4. You are required to have written permission from the property owner for <u>each location</u> that you plan to utilize.

Group 1: Temporary use for less than 72 hours - \$25.00.

Group 2: 72 hours, not to exceed 30 days - \$50.00.

Group 3: 30 - 90 days - \$75.00.

Group 4: 90+ days, not to exceed 1 year/mobile and food trucks- \$100.00.

*Note on the permit the location that the permit is to be used for, include the owner/business name and contact information.
