

## 2025 ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP SCHEDULED

Mackenzie Disposal will be providing the annual Spring Clean-up the week of

## May 5<sup>th</sup> through May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

Mackenzie Disposal will be collecting clean-out materials, yard and garden waste, branches etc.

Materials are to be placed in containers or bags. There is a maximum limit of 6 (six) bags. Branches should be cut to 4-foot lengths with a <u>Maximum of 5 bundles</u>. The collection of these materials will be during your normal scheduled collection day during this week, starting at 7:00 AM.

<u>Items that</u> <u>will not be accepted</u> for collection during this Spring clean-up are certain appliances, motorized equipment, hazardous materials, (ammunition, paints, fuels, oils, etc.) or tires.

In conjunction with the Spring Clean-up, the City of Columbus will be accepting materials at the <u>Solid Waste Container Site</u> at no charge to the customer and will have the site open for two additional days during the clean-up week. The site will be open **Wednesday**, **May 7**<sup>th</sup>; **Thursday**, **May 8**<sup>th</sup>; **Friday**, **May 9**<sup>th</sup>; **Saturday**, **May 10**<sup>th</sup>; **and Sunday**, **May 11**<sup>th</sup>. The hours that the container site will be open will be **11:00 AM to 4:00 PM**. Normal rules will apply as to what is accepted at the container site.
